## Wasatch County Arts Council Grants

Over the last seven years, the Wasatch County Arts Council has granted more than \$75,000 to local arts organizations, which include theater, orchestra, children's theater, Cowboy Poetry, after-school arts programs, and local art & music festivals.

Since the introduction of the TAP Tax in 2023, the availability of funding for art programs has changed dramatically. Wasatch County, Heber City, and Midway City now offer grants to help access TAP Tax funds. With these new funding options in place, the WCAC has decided to discontinue offering its own grants. However, our mission remains focused on actively promoting the arts in Wasatch County. We will continue to host events like the Chalk Art Festival, engage in community events, and serve as a partner for arts organizations and events.
