## ALICIA STOCKMAN MUSIC

Alicia Stockman began playing music in high school as a hobby and discovered her passion for it at the Rocky Mountain Song School in Lyons, Colorado. Realizing music could be her career, she committed to it fully, navigating its highs and lows.

She frequently plays private events and corporate gigs to fund projects like recording and tour support. Alicia has carved a niche performing in unique, remote locations in the Utah mountains, with memorable load-ins including chairlifts, gondolas, and hiking. A standout performance was playing at 10,000 feet in the Uintahs.

Her song "Halfway to Houston" was among American Songwriter's top 100 songs in 2022. She also opened for a sold-out John Hiatt show and performed at the Utah Arts Festival. Balancing the business side of music with creativity is challenging, and she often prioritizes tasks that pay the bills over songwriting.

Alicia is crowdfunding her next record, to be recorded at Freda Recording near Nashville with producer Nick Bullock. Supporters of the campaign receive rewards like album pre-orders, postcards, and unique experiences like a campfire evening or book club. 
